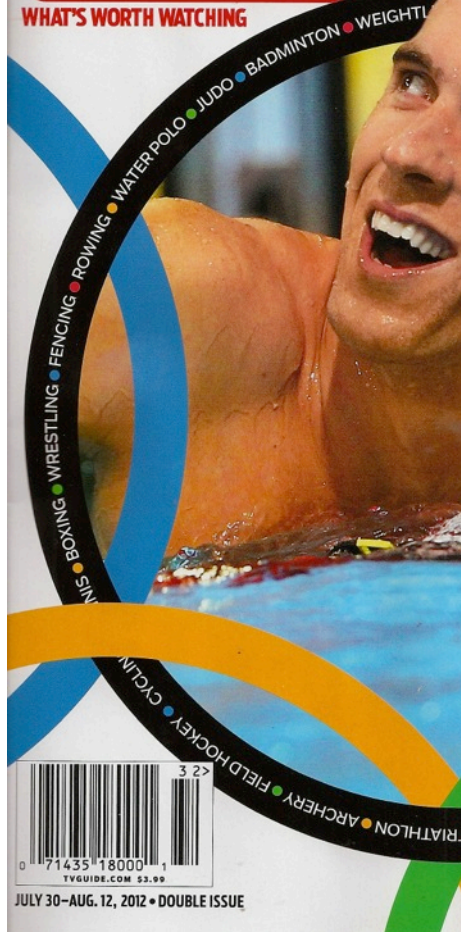

Lipstick on the Collar

What's hotter than the sandy beaches of Cape Verde, where ex-con man Neal Caffrey (Matt Bomer) spent the beginning of *White Collar*'s fourth season? The pretty young widow (*Smallville*'s Laura Vandervoort) he's smitten with now that he's back in New York and under the FBI's thumb. There's just one and tiny catch: She might actually be a murderer.

Vandervoort plays Sophie Covington, "a rich woman whose husband died and who stands to collect \$50 million," explains *Collar* creator Jeff Eastin. "Sara [*Hilarie Burton*] thinks that Sophie may have had something to do with her husband's death, so she begs Neal to look into it." Neal is, naturally, more than willing to oblige, especially after he ends up saving the widow's life and an attraction

develops between them. Adds Eastin, "He sticks around to keep an eye on her and, of course, hilarity ensues."

But it won't be all fun and games. Sara suspects that Sophie has a bad-boy lover (Peter Hermann) waiting in the wings, which could definitely spell trouble for Neal.
